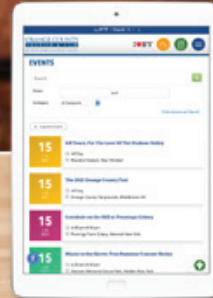

Named for its location halfway between the Hudson and Delaware Rivers City of Middletown (Orange County's 2nd largest city) and Town of Wallkill

Known for: the Orange County Fairgrounds and Orange County Fair Speedway; the historical Paramount Theatre; Randall Airport hot air balloon hub, SUNY Orange, Route 211 "Miracle Mile" shopping, Clemson Bros. Brewery, Equilibrium Brewery; Hudson Highlands State Park.

LONGITUDE: -74.692663

Nicknamed The "**River City**", it's the gateway to New York State's Upper Delaware Scenic Byway (Route 97)

Known for: Delaware River fishing and recreation; Tri-State Rock Monument; Fort Decker, historic home and Revolutionary war site; longest operating train turntable in the east, last stop on the NJ Transit-Port Jervis Line Train departing NYC Penn Station, Port Jervis Watershed Trails and Park, Foundry 42, Fox n Hare Brewing

LONGITUDE: -74.0104

Nicknamed "**Crossroads of the Northeast**", junction of Interstate 84 and Interstate 87 (NY State Thruway) City of Newburgh (Orange County's Largest City), Town of Newburgh and New Windsor

Known for: Henry Hudson Expedition 1609, Gen. George Washington's Revolutionary War Headquarters, Newburgh Waterfront Restaurant Row and sightseeing cruises, East End Historic District architecture, Mount St. Mary College, SUNY Orange, Downing Park, New York Stewart International Airport, Umbra Film Studios, Newburgh Brewing Company, Motorcyclepedia, Newburgh Illuminated Festival
